- You must be a not for profit individual, community group or organisation providing a service in, or benefit to, the **Arran** Locality.
- You must meet one or more of the **Arran** Locality themes:
 - Ideas which help to improve local life in Arran and reduce social isolation, for example developing social places for people to mix and support each other. Ideas that improve community well-being e.g. community food initiatives, healthy living, volunteering and inter-generational opportunities.
 - Ideas which support moving around on Arran for example cycling, walking and improvements to accessibility for outdoor activities.
- You can apply for any amount **up to £1,000**.
- Only one application per group/organisation can be considered.
- You must be able to spend the funds **within 12 months** if successful.
- You must be able to attend the Market Place Event on **23 March 2019 10.30am to 1pm (set up from 9am until 10.15am)**.
- You must have any legal permission required to carry out your project.
- You must allow your project to be used in any promotional material.
- You must submit your application **by 5pm on 25 February 2019**.
